

YILPORT Gemlik Serves the Largest Vessel Ever to Visit the Gulf of Gemlik

YILPORT Gemlik, the largest terminal in the Marmara Region, hosted the YM Witness Vessel, chartered by Yang Ming company. With a capacity of 14,080 TEUs, a length of 368 meters, and a width of 51 meters, the YM Witness Vessel has been recorded as the largest container vessel to enter the Gulf of Gemlik.

YM Witness Vessel is a part of MD3 - Asia - Mediterranean service, with the following port of calls: Pusan-Ningbo-Shanghai-Shekou-Singapore-Ashdod-İstanbul-İzmit-Aliaga-Mersin-Damietta -Singapore-Kaohsiung-Pusanym, respectively.



YILPORT Gävle Welcomes CMA CGM Mermaid Vessel

In June, YILPORT Gävle Container Terminal welcomed CMA CGM Mermaid, the 1st LNG-powered (Liquefied Natural Gas) vessel ever to call at the container terminal. It was handled with state-of-the-art cranes, completing 870 container moves.

Mermaid is CMA CGM's first in a series of ten ordered feeder vessels that are powered by LNG. Its sister vessel, Rundale, will also be phased into the loop via Gävle during the summer, which shows all weekly calls from CMA CGM will be LNG-powered.

Being powered by LNG means that the emissions are already 20 percent lower than if the ship runs with conventional fuel, but also that she is prepared to be powered with fossil-free LBG (biogas).

With 205 meters in length and 30 meters in width, Mermaid is the 3rd largest container ship calling at Gävle. The vessel holds a capacity of 2,000 TEUs and is designed to improve energy efficiency

and environmental performance. The new design features superstructures in the front and an almost inverted straight bow with an integrated bow bulb. These design choices are part of offering better aero and hydrodynamic performance, which is set to reduce fuel consumption by 15% per trip.

Cost-Effective Logistics Solutions

"This is a trend breaker and an important event for short sea shipping. LNG is still a fossil fuel but emits less CO2 than conventional fuel. This vessel is prepared for biogas which is completely fossil-free and hopefully, we will get there soon."

YILPORT Liscont Becomes the 2nd YILPORT Holding Terminal to Operate with A-RTG Cranes

YILPORT Liscont has achieved a significant milestone by becoming the 1st terminal in the Iberian Peninsula and the 2nd within YILPORT Holding to implement A-RTG crane operations, with 1st operation successfully unloading 50 TEUs from the Brooklyn Bridge vessel.

With 4 Remote Operations Stations (ROS), 6 A-RTG cranes currently operational and 7 more units on the way, YILPORT has made a technological leap in port automation and energy transition, contributing to the ambitious decarbonization objectives for both the YILPORT Liscont terminal and the Port of Lisbon.

Following the successful precedent set by YILPORT Gävle in Sweden, YILPORT Liscont's integration of A-RTG operations underscores our commitment to being a Game Changer in the sector-driving operational excellence, promoting sustainability, and energy transition in our operations.



YILPORT Liscont Joins the Redesigned IBESCO Service Rotation

YILPORT Liscont, with its strategic location in the heart of Lisbon, is a key route for North-South and East-West trades, serving markets in Northern Europe, West Africa, and North and South America.

The weekly IBESCO service, operated by Ocean Network Express (ONE), has now included YILPORT Liscont in its calls. This inclusion offers faster transit times and enhances existing services in Lisbon, especially for South American routes.

The updated service rotation includes the ports of YILPORT Leixões-YILPORT Liscont-London Gateway-Rotterdam-Antwerp-Gothenburg-Aarhus-Copenhagen-Helsingborg-Antwerp-Rotterdam.

The PENANG BRIDGE, 171.99 meters in length and 27.6 meters in width, has become the 1st container vessel to sail under the updated service which docked at the YILPORT Liscont terminal. YILPORT terminal investments continue to ensure that all facilities are equipped with the latest industry advancements, keeping them at the forefront of port operations.

YILPORT Leixões – JUL – Logistics Single Window - Navis Integration Project

YILPORT Leixões is the 3rd pilot region for the Janela Única Logística (JUL) project, a digital ecosystem aimed at standardizing procedures in port digitalization across Portuguese ports. The main goal is to provide a single platform for managing and accessing all ports.

JUL facilitates the efficient flow of information and documentation related to international trade and logistics processes, serving as a central hub for government agencies, customs authorities, importers, exporters, shipping agents, and logistics providers to submit, process, and share necessary data and documents.

To ensure a smooth transition, the Port Authority team and the YILPORT Holding TOS Deployment team prepared comprehensive test plans. A total of 12 operations and integration processes between the JUL and Navis systems were successfully tested at YILPORT Leixões using live operational data. The project is scheduled to go live in September 2024.



Malta Freeport extended its congratulations to CMA CGM for being the official logistics partner of the Paris 2024 Olympic and Paralympic Games.





The construction of the Frequency Converter Station and the installation of electrical equipment will commence in alignment with the Programme of Works. These operations are being carried out by Shining Star, a subsidiary of YILDIRIM Group.




Malta Freeport Hosts Auditors from the International Maritime Organization

Completion of Dredging Works at YILPORT Puerto Bolívar

These efforts included enhancing the access channel, maneuvering area and Pier 5, achieving a depth of -14.5 MMLWS with an additional tolerance of +0.50 m. Notably, Pier 6 boasted a depth of 16.5 m.

With the dredging operations concluded on May 31, the terminal now anticipates the bathymetric verification from INOCAR (Ecuadoran Oceanographic Institute of the Naval Forces).

This achievement marks a crucial step in ensuring the navigability of our facilities and supporting the economic and environmental goals of the region, while meeting the highest standards necessary to optimize our operations and improve the efficiency of the services offered.
